

The EU Copyright Directive

How the new text balances the interests of all stakeholders

Article 13

If platforms give access to large amounts of copyright works



Licensing agreements are concluded

Platforms & rightholders cooperate, rules vary for small and startup services

Non-infringing material & works covered by exceptions stay up

Automated blocking and general monitoring banned

Fundamental rights are upheld for creators and citizens

All authors & performers benefit from new rules on fair remuneration, contracts & transparency



Article 13 also needed to help make these provisions meaningful

Licences automatically cover uploads by citizens

No arbitrary take down or surveillance

Rules on privacy & personal data are respected



Copyright exceptions reinforced

Redress mechanism includes human review & independent body

Memes, GIFs

Open source software e.g. GitHub

Quotation criticism review

Not affected by Art.13

Passive platforms

Caricature parody pastiche

Online marketplaces like eBay, & cloud services

Not-for profit encyclopedias, educational & scientific repositories
